Hamden intersection to undergo change

Hamden (WTNH) -- Changes are on the way for a intersection that's been the scene of numerous accidents in recent years.

Wednesday night, Hamden's Traffic Commission voted in favor of making a four-way stop at the intersection of Haverford Street and Ridge Road.

There have been numerous accidents at the intersection including one in which a car was hit by an ambulance.

The police chief says cars driving too fast through the area has been an issue.

"The police department, in a time from July to August 29th, conducted 14 speed enforcements," Chief Tom Wydra said. "That created 100 stops...most for speeders."

Over the past four years, there have been nine accidents at the intersection.
